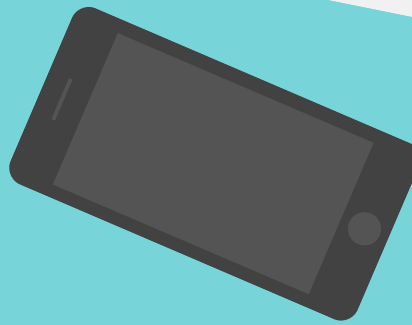

The division has 14 FTE professional staff with additional part-time and seasonal staff .
